



## Indoor American VII 29<sup>th</sup> January 2017

We are back again for another unusual shoot – doing the American round indoors. The shoot has been very popular over the last few years and we will be following the same trusted format.

Don't miss out - get your entry in early as we only have 96 spaces through the day.

The last Sunday in January was chosen because generally we seem to have turned the corner and archers are starting to look forward to the outdoor season. The chance to shoot outdoor distances in January with no wind, rain or snow has got to be good.

2.5 dozen arrows at each distance of 60, 50 and 40yds, 7.5 dozen in total.

Garmin say that Wix Equestrian Centre is 41 miles and 32 minutes (mostly dual carriageway) from Perris Archery at Rettenden, who are sponsoring the event.

Please try and save your sight marks from this year as we would like to minimise archers using this venue to "find" new ones, it really is not ideal. We have to try to avoid any damage to the centre walls, plate glass mirrors and of course your arrows.

Wix Equestrian Centre has a floor of shavings and rubber chippings, and as you might expect there may be extras. The café will be open all day for plenty of refreshments.

The lighting is OK but there is no heating so dress for warmth and comfort as no dress regulations will apply.
