Purpose

- 3. The NAA is committed to equal opportunity for people to participate in the sport and promotes equitable access for participation in Club activities
- 4. The NAA does not tolerate discriminatory or oppressive behaviour of any kind and will enforce disciplinary action in response to any behaviour deemed as such
- 5. The NAA maintains policies and procedures to ensure equal opportunity and to eradicate discrimination, harassment, vilification, abuse and actions of intolerance
- 6. The NAA is committed to taking positive action where inequalities exist and the development of a program of on-going training and awareness in order to promote diversity in our sport
- 7. In seeking for diversity within all aspects of archery, the NAA is committed to providing relevant training to its Committee Members and club representatives if deemed necessary for them to work effectively within their role, e.g. Disability Awareness Training, Cultural Awareness Training
